

Privacy Policy

AIDS Assistance Program (aidsassistance.org) is committed to protecting your privacy. You can visit most pages on our site without giving us any information about yourself, but sometimes we do need information to provide services that you request, and this privacy statement explains data collection and use in those situations. This privacy statement only applies to aidsassistance.org.

Collection of your Personal Information

□ We will ask you when we need information that personally identifies you (personal information) or allows us to contact you. Generally, this information is requested when you are subscribing to our newsletter or purchasing tickets to our events. Personal information collected by aidsassistance.org often is limited to name, company title, company address, company telephone numbers and e-mail address, company website, RSVP information, such as guest names, etc., but may include other information when needed to provide a membership service you request. □□ Aidsassistance.org may also collect certain information about your computer hardware and software. This information may include your IP address, browser type, operating system, domain name, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of aidsassistance.org. Aidsassistance.org also collects information about which pages our customers visit within our website. This site visitation data is identified only by a unique ID number, and it is never linked with personal information. □□ Aidsassistance.org may disclose your personal information if required to do so by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on AIDS Assistance Program or the website; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of AIDS Assistance Program, or (c) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of AIDS Assistance Program employees, board of directors, members or users of our properties or services, or members of the public. □□

Control of your Personal Information

When you subscribe to our e-mail newsletter or otherwise give us personal information, we will not share that information with third parties without your permission, other than for the limited exceptions already listed. It will only be used for the purposes stated above. Subscribing to our e-mail newsletter also allows you to tell us how or whether you want us to communicate with you. After subscribing to our newsletter, you may unsubscribe if you choose to no longer to receive the email newsletter by logging in and opting out of receiving the e-newsletter.

Use of Cookies

When someone visits aidsassistance.org, a cookie is placed on the visitor's computer (if the visitor accepts cookies) or is read if the visitor has visited the site previously. One use of cookies is to assist in the login of returning subscribers or members (future).
